3. **Peter** is imprisoned and awaits execution.
4. The greatest **prison break** in history!
5. The **power of prayer** is once again revealed.
6. **Rhoda** and the case of the unopened door.
7. **Tyre** and **Sidon** need help from Herod.
8. **Herod Agrippa**, grandson of **Herod the Great** becomes **Herod the Dead**.
9. Our hearts must be changed by God so we become like **Christ** and not Herod.
10. **Saul, Barnabas** and **John Mark** enter the story.

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
